History of the CAF U-17 Africa Cup of Nations – CECAFA qualifiers

The CAF U-17 Africa Cup of Nations was started by the Confederation of African Football (CAF) as a biennial youth competition for players under the age of 17. It also serves as the African qualification tournament for the FIFA U-17 World Cup.

The qualifiers are played at Zonal level to select the two best teams which eventually play at the continental showpiece.

2018

The qualifiers for the CECAFA Zone were held in Dar es Salaam, Tanzania.

Nine teams participated in the qualifiers. Uganda handled by coach Peter Onen defeated Ethiopia 3-1 in the final to qualify for their first ever CAF U-17 Africa Cup of Nations.



2020

Rwanda hosted the qualifiers of the CECAFA Zone in the Town of Rubavu

Six teams including Rwanda took part in the tournament during the tough COVID 19 period. Uganda stopped Djibouti, while Tanzania eliminated Ethiopia at the semi-final stage. Uganda went on to stop Tanzania 3-1 in the final.



2022

Somalia emerged champions of the Zonal qualifiers after stopping South Sudan 3-1 in the final in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia

Nine teams took part in the qualifiers. To reach the final Somalia ejected Uganda, and South Sudan saw-off Tanzania at the semi-final stage.

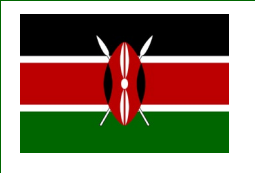
